Colleagues,

The Michigan Department of Community Health's Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) program, in partnership with the Michigan Public Health Institute's Office of Accreditation and Quality Improvement, has embarked on a process to develop local health department performance measures and revise the CSHCS Michigan Local Public Health Accreditation Program (MLPHAP) Minimum Program Requirements (MPRs) and Indicators. The process includes the creation of the CSHCS Performance Measures Workgroup, a subcommittee of the CSHCS Local Health Department Advisory Committee. The Workgroup is comprised of CSHCS staff, MLPHAP reviewers, and Local Health Department staff. In cooperation with stakeholders the workgroup aims to:

- Gather background information that will help formulate useful, relevant local health department performance measures for the CSHCS program.
- Assess the strengths and limitations of the current CSHCS Michigan Local Public Health Accreditation Program Minimum Program Requirements and Indicators.

- Revise Minimum Program Requirements as needed and ensure that Indicators are meaningful and measurable.
- Develop a CSHCS Program Performance Measures report card with benchmarks for local health departments.
