Michigan Department of Community Health's Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) program, in partnership with the Michigan Public Health Institute's Office of Accreditation and Quality Improvement developed revised Minimum Performance Requirements (MPRs) and Indicators for the CSHCS Michigan Local Public Health Accreditation Program (MLPHAP). The revision process included the CSHCS Performance Measures Workgroup, a subcommittee of the CSHCS Local Health Department Advisory Committee. The Workgroup comprised of CSHCS staff, MLPHAP reviewers, Local Health Department staff, and family representatives that met monthly to revise the MPRs and Indicators.
