

ANNUAL REPORTS PROVIDED BY CMHSPS OR SPECIALTY PREPAID HEALTH PLANS

(FY2009 Appropriation Bill - Public Act 246 of 2008)

May 31, 2009

Section 604: (1) The CMHSPs or PIHPs shall provide annual reports to the department on the following information: (a) The number of days of care purchased from state hospitals and centers. (b) The number of days of care purchased from private hospitals in lieu of purchasing days of care from state hospitals and centers. (c) The number and type of alternative placements to state hospitals and centers other than private hospitals. (d) Waiting lists for placements in state hospitals and centers. (2) The department shall annually report the information in subsection (1) to the house of representatives and senate appropriations subcommittees on community health, the house and senate fiscal agencies, and the state budget director.

Section 604(1)(a): The number of days of care purchased from state hospitals and centers. Attached is information from the MDCH Financial Systems office, which represents the number of days purchased from state-operated hospitals and centers. This information represents data from October 1, 2007 – September 30, 2008 by the 46 community mental health service programs (CMHSPs) in Michigan. Information is presented for adults and children with mental illness as well as individuals with developmental disabilities.

Section 604(1)(b): The number of days purchased from private hospitals in lieu of purchasing days of care from state hospitals and centers. Attached is information on inpatient days purchased from community hospitals from October 1, 2007 – September 30, 2008. Data are obtained from the Community Mental Health Warehouse Encounter Data, FY 2008, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Administration. Numbers are presented for the 46 community mental health services programs for adults and children with mental illness as well as individuals who are developmentally disabled.

Section 604(1)(c): The number and type of alternative placements to state hospitals and centers other than private hospitals. Attached is information on the number and type of alternative placements from October 1, 2007 – September 30, 2008. Data are obtained from the Community Mental Health Warehouse Encounter Data, FY 2008, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Administration. Numbers are presented for the 46 community mental health services programs for individuals with mental illness as well as individuals with developmental disabilities. For individuals with mental illness, alternative placements include partial hospitalization, specialized residential, supported independent housing, and crisis residential. For individuals with developmental disabilities numbers are presented for those in specialized residential settings.

Section 604(1)(d): Waiting list for placements in state hospitals and centers.
