Are You Concerned About the Behavior of an Infant or Toddler In Child Care?

For example, a 6-month old who doesn't seem to smile or coo, a 9-month old who cries and can't be calmed, or a two-year old who bites a lot? Are you wondering where to turn for ideas and support?

CCEP can help!

What is CCEP?

CCEP is a free consultation service that helps families and child care providers to promote infant-toddler social, emotional and behavioral health and turn challenging behavior around.

Why Promote Social and Emotional Health?

Because it's fundamental to success in school and life. Social and emotional health is a child's growing ability to:

- Form close relationships with others
- Express and manage emotions (e.g., an infant cries when upset and is able to be calmed by a familiar adult)
- Explore his or her surroundings and learn

Children who struggle to develop social and emotional skills often have challenging behaviors. These behaviors can get in the way of learning. The sooner we find out what is causing a challenging behavior, the easier it is to help the child.

What Services Does CCEP Provide?

- **Free phone or e-mail consultation.** Consultants are available to answer questions about infant-toddler social and emotional health and challenging behaviors.
- **Free on-site consultation.** Consultants can meet with parents and providers to plan and implement strategies to assist infants and toddlers with challenging behaviors. They don't label children. Their job is to help parents and providers to help the child.

Who is Eligible for CCEP?

- Child care providers who are licensed, registered or enrolled with the Department of Human Services (DHS)
AND
- Care for children birth up to 36 months who are receiving or eligible to receive the DHS child care subsidy.
