


# Co-occurrence of Substance Use Among Youth in Michigan in 2013

Youth who engage in one substance-related behavior are much more likely to engage in another<sup>1</sup>. The diagram below offers a look at substance use amongst high schoolers in Michigan in 2013.

## Percent of Youth 12 to 17 Years of Age Reporting Drinking Alcohol, Using Marijuana, or Using Prescription Drugs Without a Doctor's Prescription: MI Students 2013



- Among all high school students, almost half (44.6%) reported drinking alcohol or using marijuana within the last 30 days, or abusing prescription drugs in their lifetime. 28.3% reported drinking alcohol in the past 30 days. 18.2% reported using marijuana in the past 30 days. 16.2% reported abusing prescription drugs in their lifetime.
