

**FINGERTIP REPORT: B.2. SERVICE UTILIZATION SUMMARY for
Children with Serious Emotional Disorders
Medicaid-Funded Services Only
Period: 10/1/2012 - 9/30/2013**

During Fiscal Year 2013 (October 1, 2012 – September 30, 2013), the community mental health system served 38,370 children with serious emotional disorders (SED) whose services were covered through Medicaid funds. Table B shows the number and percentage of children with serious emotional disorders who received evidence-based services including Homebased services, Wraparound, and Parent Management Training.
