


Going fishing this summer in the Lange and Revere Canals?



The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) issued a “**Do Not Eat Advisory**” for the fish caught in the Lange and Revere Canals in St. Clair Shores.

Unsafe levels of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) were found in fish caught in these two canals. While fishing is allowed, MDCH **strongly** recommends that people do **not** eat the fish caught in the Lange and Revere Canals.

Eating these fish can harm your health. You may not experience health issues right away but your health may be affected years from now.

Do Not Eat Fish From These Canals

The Michigan Department of Community Health has found unsafe levels of chemicals (PCBs) in fish from the Lange and Revere Canals.
