

MDCH Announces Refreshed CHAMPS ICD-10 B2B Test System

CHAMPS ICD-10 B2B Test System Has New History and Test Compliance Date

The CHAMPS ICD-10 B2B Test system has been upgraded to include transaction history from January 1st, 2013 through June 6th, 2014; and to use a new dummy test compliance date of June 1st, 2014. We anticipate this expansion to seventeen months of available transaction history will aid our ICD-10 Trading Partners in your testing efforts.

Providers and Trading Partners are asked to test claim adjudication and encounter processing functions using the CHAMPS ICD-10 B2B Test environment. We will provide claim adjudication and (if requested) 835 remittance advice reports; or encounter error reports, to our Trading Partners for use in your own ICD-10 review and testing functions. Providers and Trading Partners may send us test transactions as follows:

- 1) Trading Partners may submit batch test transactions generated by your ICD-10 transaction system, using the regular Data Exchange Gateway (DEG) test file submission procedure. Trading Partners who submit 837, 270, or 276 transaction files through Michigan's DEG must identify test files with a "T" suffix, as per normal testing practice. Additional information is available in the MDCH Electronic Submissions Manual on the MDCH website under Providers (Trading Partners >> HIPAA - Companion Guides >> Electronic Submissions Manual).
- 2) Providers who currently submit claims using Michigan's web-access SSO logon may also request access to the CHAMPS - ICD10 Parallel/B2B Test system in order to: a) retrieve your historical transactions (already processed in CHAMPS production between January 1st, 2013 and June 6th, 2014); b) re-code the claims using ICD-10 codes with new service dates (using a dummy test compliance date of June 1st, 2014); and c) submit the re-coded claims as test transactions.
