Dear Stakeholder:

As you are likely aware, the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) has contracted with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to develop a proposal to integrate funding and services for beneficiaries of both Medicare and Medicaid. From June through December 2011, MDCH undertook an extensive stakeholder engagement process to seek input from people who are likely to be affected by the proposal so that it best meets the needs of people who receive services and those who provide services and supports.

Based on information gathered during the stakeholder engagement process, CMS guidance, and analysis of the population to be served, MDCH has drafted a proposal for submission to CMS, which is available for review and public comment through April 4. MDCH is hosting two public meetings to review the proposal with stakeholders. Dates, times, and locations are as follows:
