Dear Adult Home Help Provider:

This letter describes changes in the Adult Home Help program.

1. Union dues will no longer be taken from your paycheck. **This starts March 1, 2013.** Union dues will be taken out for work performed through February 28, 2013. Union dues will not be taken out for work on and after March 1, 2013.
2. The Michigan Department of Community Health will be operating the Provider Registry. Until recently, the Michigan Quality Community Care Council (MQCCC) operated the provider registry. The phone number for the registry will remain the same at (800) 979-4662. Future communications will come from the Michigan Department of Community Health. Other Provider Registry operations will remain the same.

Participation in the Provider Registry is an option for Adult Home Help providers. The purpose of the registry is to help beneficiaries find providers and help providers find opportunities for more work hours. If you would like more information about the Provider Registry, call (800) 979-4662.
