RE: Notification of intent to submit a State Plan Amendment to revise the Michigan Medicaid Cost Report

In compliance with Section 6505 of the Affordable Care Act, this letter serves as notice of intent to all Tribal Chairs and Health Directors of the request by the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for clinic services.
