You qualify for help if:

- ❖ You have a child under 6 years old living in or visiting the home on a regular basis
- ❖ You are a low-moderate income family
- ❖ You live in a home built before 1978
- ❖ You live in Berrien, Calhoun, Genesee, Ingham, Kalamazoo, Muskegon, Oakland or Wayne county **OR** your child has an elevated blood lead level (10 or above)
- ❖ You own or rent the home



What is included?

- ❖ Free Cleaning Kit, including cleaning supplies and door mats
- ❖ Free Lead Inspection/Risk Assessment (\$500 value) and report of findings
- ❖ Lead Hazard Control work which may include new windows and doors and special cleaning and painting.

What is the cost?

- ❖ **Owner Occupied** – Almost FREE! We ask that homeowners give up to \$300, depending on income.
- ❖ **Landlords**- We provide up to \$4,000 per unit; Landlords must come up with the rest. We will also provide assistance in applying for a low-interest loan for lead hazard control.
- ❖ **Tenants**- We need your landlord's permission before beginning work on the home.
