The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) is submitting a waiver amendment and HCBS transition plan for the MI Choice waiver to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The amendment will allow an increase in enrollment for the MI Choice waiver. The purpose of the MI Choice HCBS transition plan is to describe how MDCH will meet federal requirements for providing MI Choice home and community-based services in the most integrated settings (residential and non-residential).
