Objectives for B2B Testing

- Ensure MDCH and our trading partners are ready for implementation of HIPAA v5010 transactions by January 1, 2012
- Ensure our Substance Abuse CAs can:
 - Successfully send 837 v5010 encounters to CHAMPS
 - Successfully retrieve and process v5010 validation output files (TA1s, 999s) as well as audit html files and ETRRs from CHAMPS and the DEG
 - Successfully retrieve 5010 versions of the 834 and 820 transactions from CHAMPS

B2B Test Approach

- Two-stage approach for 837 v5010 encounter test files:
 - Stage 1 – Validation via web-based Ramp Manager EDIFECS HIPAA validator
 - Stage 2 – Encounter processing through CHAMPS 5010 B2B Test System
- Test versions of v5010 834 and 820 transaction files will be loaded to your DEG mailbox; email notices will be sent to your contacts set up in Ramp Manager

B2B Test Tracking

- Tracking of B2B Testing activity will be managed through the MDCH Ramp Manager site: (<https://sites.edifecs.com/index.jsp?Michigan>)
- Site access credentials (ID, password) and instructions have been emailed to all SA CAs
- Ramp Manager contains multi-step test programs by transaction; we have enrolled our SA CAs in common, expected transactions (837E, 820, 834)
- We will enroll SA CAs to allow testing of other transactions (e.g., batch 270/271), if requested

CHAMPS B2B Testing Timeline

- Stage 1 testing for 837 v5010 encounters available now; all SA CAs should log in, download testing instructions, update contact information, upload test encounters, request approval
- Stage 2 testing for 837 v5010 encounters begins after completion of Stage 1 testing
- We are currently performing Stage 2 testing with trading partners approved for Stage 1 testing
- All Stage 2 testing to be completed by 12/22/11!

CHAMPS B2B Testing Timeline

- Test versions of 834 v5010 enrollment and 820 v5010 payment transactions will be produced for pilot plans in July and all plans from August through December 2011
- Email notices will be sent to contacts enrolled in Ramp Manager when 834s and 820s have been posted to your DEG mailbox
- Please log into Ramp Manager to confirm your ability to retrieve and process your 834s and 820s
- 834 and 820 testing must also be completed by 12/22/11

Encounter Testing Notes

- Stage 1 Testing
 - Focus is on format and data structure
 - Ramp Manager will identify errors for you
 - Ramp Manager does not perform “database oriented” edits, which will be tested during Stage 2 (e.g., valid NPI or beneficiary ID)
 - We want to see at least 30 representative v5010 837 encounters uploaded and accepted, including some with both primary and secondary payer (COB) data

Encounter Testing Notes

- Stage 2 - 837 Encounters
 - Encounter processing results in production of a 999 and, if successful, an ETRR report
 - Encounter dates of service must correspond to data in our B2B test environment. We have loaded eligibility and TEDS data through April 6, 2011. Additional data will be loaded monthly
 - Please email MDCH-B2B-Testing@Michigan.gov and AutomatedBilling@Michigan.gov with each test file submission

Encounter Testing Notes

- Stage 2 – 834s and 820s
 - 834 data will be representative, but not identical to production eligibility data/834s (not all of our data feeds are being run in test)
