**Subject:** Implementation Delay of October 2006 Quarterly HCPCS for Power Mobility Devices

**Effective:** Upon Receipt

**Programs Affected:** Medicaid and Children's Special Health Care Services

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has recently delayed the effective date of the new Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) procedure codes for the power mobility procedure codes until November 15, 2006. Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) will follow the same effective date for these codes.

The following HCPCS procedure codes will be covered for Medical Suppliers (Provider Types 85, 87). Prior authorization is required for all codes.
