Subject: Sanctioned Provider Notification Process

Effective: January 1, 2013

Programs Affected: Medicaid, Adult Benefits Waiver, Children's Special Health Care Services, Waiver for Children with Serious Emotional Disturbances, Children's Waiver Program, Maternity Outpatient Medical Services, MIChoice Waiver, *Plan First!*

The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) currently issues Medicaid policy bulletins throughout the year notifying providers of updates to the MDCH Sanctioned Provider List. This list contains information regarding providers currently sanctioned by MDCH, the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, the Office of the Inspector General, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Effective January 1, 2013, MDCH will no longer issue policy bulletins notifying providers of updates to the MDCH Sanctioned Provider List. The list will be continuously updated on the MDCH website as sanction information is received and notification will not be sent when these updates occur. Providers should check the MDCH website, as well as the websites of other sanctioning bodies, to avoid accepting orders/prescriptions for Medicaid beneficiaries from sanctioned providers.

Further information regarding the Sanctioned Provider process can be found in the General Information for Providers Chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual. The Sanctioned Provider List is posted on the MDCH website at www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders >> Billing and Reimbursement >> List of Sanctioned Providers.
