If you have mild or moderate mental health needs such as depression or anxiety, you will receive medically necessary mental health services from your health plan. If you have mild or moderate mental health needs such as depression or anxiety and you are not enrolled in a health plan, you may receive mental health services from an enrolled provider in the Michigan Medicaid program.

If you have a developmental disability, mental illness, serious emotional disturbance or substance use disorder you will receive medically necessary specialty mental health and substance abuse services through the prepaid inpatient mental health plan for your area. Medically necessary is a term used to describe one of the criteria that must be met in order for a beneficiary to receive Medicaid services. The specific specialty service is expected to help the beneficiary with a mental health, developmental disability or substance use condition. Some services assess needs and some services help maintain or improve functioning.
