<b>SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS</b>	
<p><b>Welcome and Introductions:</b></p> <p>Minou Carey opened the meeting by thanking members for attending, followed by introductions.</p> <p><b>Approval of Minutes:</b></p> <p>Minutes were approved with one revision.</p> <p><b>Summary of Agenda Items:</b></p> <p>Larry Scott provided the RxOTC Drug Abuse Workgroup members with Director Dazzo’s Transitional Performance Measures document for the MDCH, and gave examples of how Governor Snyder’s Performance Dashboard impacts mental health and substance abuse services. Dianne Perukel volunteered to share Michigan State Police metrics with the group, as well. Felix Sharpe mentioned how obesity was an additional concern, and that the group should consider possible opportunities for collaboration and shared goals. Mr. Sharpe recommended the Michigan State Medical Society as an appropriate platform. Mr. Sharpe also presented the question as to whether the state of the budget could impact workgroup efforts. Mr. Scott spoke about possible grant opportunities, including partnering with new Drug Free Community grantees. He also mentioned that all coordinating agencies (CAs) will be required to address RxOTC drug abuse existing funding. Mr. Sharpe indicated that we anticipate changes, but are unsure as to what those changes are at this time. He also explained that there are no federal cuts this year, but a \$317,000.00 cut is expected for fiscal year (FY) 2012.</p> <p>Ms. Carey provided an overview of the RxOTC Drug Abuse Summit Workgroup’s recommended goals for review and discussion. The workgroup conducted an initial discussion around treatment goals identified by the RxOTC Drug Abuse Summit, and concluded that the group would focus on areas of prevention, with an overarching theme of advocacy and environmental change.</p> <p>It was also noted that there is a gap in data for adults 55 years-of-age and older. Mr. Sharpe mentioned that BSAAS has a pilot initiative through the Michigan Automated Prescription Service (MAPS) that</p>	

assesses patients who are identified as “doctor shoppers” to identify the physician and offer the user treatment. Mr. Sharpe also mentioned that this is the second year of the grant and this should to be connected to the group. Jill Worden mentioned that there is a possibility that MAPS may be defunded.

Poly-pharmacy is defined as “the prescribing of multiple medications in elderly populations.” Could we have a strategy to increase public awareness? A presentation on poly-pharmacy was offered.

Additional key points about the discussion of data are as follows:

- National Survey on Drug Use and Health will provide CA level data for 2008. This data can be used as an outcome measure.
- The Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS) can be acquired for clients funded in whole, or in part, by BSAAS administered funds.
- MAPS data can be sorted by zip codes.
- Ms. Worden has FY 2008 and 2009 data. There is a huge increase in the number of prescriptions, despite the decrease in populations.
- Su Min reviewed the National Risk Behavioral Survey data and it does not include RxOTC drug abuse data.

**Discussion Points/(Decisions Reached):**

There are five priority areas identified by the RxOTC Drug Abuse Workgroup:

1. To accurately define the problem of RxOTC drug abuse and steps that can be taken to reduce abuse.
2. To increase multi-system communication and collaboration at all levels around RxOTC drug abuse and related problems.
3. To increase and expand addiction education and the use of brief screenings by various medical fields and their students.
4. To improve access, usage, and content of MAPS.
5. To broaden statewide media messages, including sector specific efforts.

**Next Steps/Action Items:**

- Find out if MAPS is being defunded.
- Find out if the Michigan Profile for Healthy Youth (MiPHY) RxOTC drug abuse questions are being added to the Youth Risk Behavior Survey for 2011.
- Invite the present Demand Reduction Officer for Detroit to our Workgroup.
- Add drugged driving and prescribed drugs to the data source guide. Ms. Perukel will present the information.
- Michigan Hospital Admission Data will be reviewed by Kim Hekman.
- Su Min will revise and update the data source document and send to the RxOTC Drug Abuse Workgroup.
- Judicial office data will be provided by Ms. Perukel.
