Note: In each of these categories, those clients who entered treatment with a status that was already positive (zero use at admission, employed, and/or not homeless) are excluded. For these persons, 83.5% of those who reported no use at their first service maintained their abstinence. 98.4% of those in a stable living situation reported that they remained in one on their last date of service, and 77.8% of those employed reported that they kept their employed status on their last date of service.
