

VFC Tip Sheet: Reporting NDCs for Vaccines

A provider must report the national drug code (NDC) of the vaccine that is administered to a Medicaid Fee-for-Service beneficiary. The reporting of the NDC is required even if the beneficiary has other insurance that is primary.

A provider may use the NDC that is listed on the outer box of the vaccine package. However, if a single dose of vaccine is received and there is not an outer box, the NDC from the vaccine vial or syringe may be used.

MDCH will work with CDC to encourage vaccine manufacturers to include all NDCs for all vaccines, including box, vial and syringes to ensure that all NDCs have been appropriately reported. Medicaid is working on a FAQ sheet about reporting NDCs and it should be released in the near future. MDCH will update LHDs on any new information about NDCs as we receive it.
