

On April 1, 1963, Michigan voters approved a new Constitution – the first in the United States to create a Civil Rights Commission charged with securing equal protection without discrimination.

As part of our observance of that anniversary, <u>Michigan Department of Civil Rights</u> (MDCR) colleagues and Commission members, where possible, are embarking on a 50 city tour.

We will be meeting with community members, business leaders, law enforcement, educators, local media, volunteers, advocates, the faith-based community and others in a series of events across the state. In some locations, we will provide training opportunities on a variety of civil rights issues. In others, we may host a public forum on a topic chosen by the community.
