**Lansing**-The Michigan Civil Rights Commission (MCRC) has re-opened the search for an Executive Director to lead the Michigan Department of Civil Rights (MDCR). Applications for the position must be received by 5 PM on Friday, August 23, 2013.

The MDCR Executive Director will be responsible for implementing public policy set forth by the Michigan Civil Rights Commission, including providing executive leadership for MDCR and its employees. MDCR is responsible for civil rights complaint investigations as well as outreach efforts and educational programs to promote voluntary compliance with civil rights laws.
