**Michigan Civil Rights Commission to Meet Monday, June 1
in Dearborn**

Lansing - The Michigan Civil Rights Commission will host a regular public meeting at 5 pm on Monday, June 1, at the Arab American National Museum, 13624 Michigan Avenue in Dearborn, 48126. The meeting will be held in the museum auditorium.

Rana Abbas, Director of Communications and Marketing for the Arab Community Center for Economic and Social Services (ACCESS) will provide an update on TAKE ON HATE, a multi-year, grassroots campaign to challenge this country's growing prejudice and persistent misconception of Arab and Muslim Americans. The organization announced the launch of the campaign last June from MDCR's Detroit office.

Individuals who wish to address the Commission on civil rights issues will have an opportunity to speak during the public comment period at the end of the meeting.
