The role of the Eligibility Specialist is to strengthen Michigan families by: Encouraging and guiding families in their efforts to become self-supporting. Ensuring that each person/family that applies for public assistance receives the type and level of assistance that they are eligible for. Assessing the needs of each person/family and giving them appropriate information and making any referrals and/or contacts to persons/agencies to help them meet their needs.
