- **SUBJECT:** College-Level Equivalent Course Directory

In collaboration with the College Board and Michigan College Access Network (MCAN), the Michigan Department of Education has published the <u>Advanced</u> <u>Placement Course Directory</u>. This directory, required under <u>MCL 380.1474</u>, cross-references credits awarded for specific classes at Michigan public colleges and universities, based on the score attained in specific Advanced Placement (AP) courses or College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams.

Also published on the <u>MDE website</u> are links to <u>AP</u> and <u>CLEP</u> college policy search tools. These tools list the scores on AP and CLEP exams needed to receive credit at more than 2,900 colleges and universities across the United States.
