SUBJECT: 2010-11 Math/Science Centers Section 99(6) Grant

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is pleased to announce the 2010-11 Math/Science Centers Section 99(6) Grant. Approximately \$750,000 will be made available for this initiative. The detailed grant announcement and application instructions can be found online at www.michigan.gov/mde-grants under the "What's New" section. This is a competitive grant program targeted to the Michigan Intermediate School Districts (ISDs).

The purpose of the 2010-11 Math/Science Centers Section 99(6) Grant is to provide assistance implementing the Michigan Merit Curriculum components for science and mathematics.

A single grant of up to \$750,000 will be made to an ISD to work in partnership with the Michigan Mathematics and Science Centers Network.

Grant applications must be submitted to the MDE by mail. Applications must be submitted by Friday, October 29, 2010.
