**SUBJECT:** 2018-19 Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A Final Allocation Increases for Eligible Local Educational Agencies

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Office of Educational Supports (OES) is pleased to announce additional funding for the 2018-19 Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A grants. These amounts have been made available and have been distributed to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) that were eligible for these grants in School Year 2018-19 and met the eligibility requirements to receive additional funding. The updated 2018-19 Final Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A Allocation lists are posted on the OES website on the [Program Allocations](#) page under Tools & Resources.

These additional funds will be available for usage as Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A Carryover in the eligible LEA's 2020 (2019-20) Consolidated Application in MEGS+. LEAs may choose to apply for these additional 2018-19 Title II, Part A Carryover funds and, if applicable, Title IV, Part A Carryover funds in their 2020 (2019-20) Consolidated Application. The Consolidated Application amendment due date has been extended to **January 31, 2020**. Due to the small increases in 2018-19 Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A funding, should LEAs choose **not** to apply for these funds in their 2020 (2019-20) Consolidated Application, the additional funds will automatically move forward into their 2021 (2020-21) Consolidated Application as part of 2021 (2020-21) Carryover funds.
