SUBJECT: 2020 United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP)

The United States Senate Youth Program, established in 1962 by U.S. Senate Resolution, is a unique educational experience for outstanding high school students interested in pursuing careers in public service. The 58th annual program will be held in Washington, D.C., from March 7-14, 2020. It provides an opportunity for qualified high school juniors and seniors to deepen their understanding of America's political processes. Please make sure this opportunity is available to all interested students.

This initiative aligns with Michigan's Top 10 in 10 Years Strategic Plan Goal 2: Implement, with strong district and building leadership, high-quality instruction in every classroom through a highly coherent, child-centered instructional model where students meet their self-determined academic and personal goals to their highest potential.

Two students are selected from each state. Each student will receive an all-expense paid trip to attend *Washington, D.C. Week*, March 7-14, 2020 and a \$10,000 undergraduate college scholarship award.
