The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Office of Career and Technical Education (OCTE) is accepting nominations for the 2021 Excellence in Practice Awards to be presented during the OCTE spring update on Wednesday, April 21, 2021. At this time, the event is scheduled to take place in Grand Rapids, pending the status of the pandemic.

There are two categories of awards:

- 1. The career and technical education outstanding program Excellence in Practice Award recognizes a successful, exemplary, state-approved career and technical education (CTE) program that demonstrates outstanding outcomes, produces measurable results, and leads to documented success in employment, postsecondary education, or apprenticeship.
- 2. The career and college readiness initiative Excellence in Practice Award recognizes outstanding practices, programs, or services that demonstrate exemplary support of career and college planning for students. These activities assist students in their academic readiness, connect students to their career cluster of interest, and link their career options and educational decisions to prepare them for high-wage, high-skill, in-demand careers.
