**Percentage of 5th Graders Proficient on the MEAP**




## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades


**Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades**


**Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades**

**Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP**




**Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades**

**Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP**




## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades

## Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP










Average MME Scale Scores 2009




### Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades

### Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP




## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades

## Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP






