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Mathematics MEAP

- No future core expectations
- 7 forms
- Grade 3: no calculator
- Grades 4 – 8: Part 1 no calculator
Part 2 calculator permitted

No constructed response items

Test Lengths

- Grade 3: $26 + 27 = 53$
- Grade 4: $44 + 18 = 62$
- Grade 5: $46 + 16 = 62$
- Grade 6: $36 + 25 = 61$
- Grade 7: $39 + 24 = 63$
- Grade 8: $14 + 45 = 59$

MEAP dates
