SUBJECT: Quarterly ARRA Section 1512 Report Due October 5, 2010

The next American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Section 1512 quarterly report is **due October 5, 2010**. Section 1512 reporting must be completed quarterly in the Michigan Electronic Grants System (MEGS) for each ARRA grant award received.

The Section 1512 Reporting application is now available in MEGS. Complete the report by initiating an amendment to your existing ARRA Section 1512 report.

The reporting period for this quarter's report is July 1, 2010 – September 30, 2010. The next quarterly report will be due January 5, 2011.

Instructional documents for the 1512 Reporting requirements are available. **It is strongly recommended that you review these documents prior to completing this quarterly report.** In addition, the U.S. Department of Education has recently released clarifying guidance regarding FTE calculations. It is available online at <http://www2.ed.gov/policy/gen/leg/recovery/10-0349-job-guid-clarify-8-10.doc>.

For any ARRA grant, if all grant activities have been completed and a final expenditure report has been processed, recipients need to check the box within the reporting application to indicate that the grant is complete.

In keeping with the increased transparency and accountability requirements of the ARRA, reports submitted pursuant to Section 1512 of the Recovery Act will be made available on [www.recovery.gov](http://www.recovery.gov) and on individual Federal agency recovery websites.
