SUBJECT: Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Accountability & Accreditation School/District Reporting Requirements

This communication is to inform you of the reporting requirements for federal and state accountability and accreditation. You are required to submit the following online reports (during the designated timeframes) which are accessible through the AdvancED [ASSIST website](#):

SCHOOL REPORTS

- EdYES! ReportDue March 18, 2016 or *4 weeks prior to AdvancED External Review
 - School Systems Review (SSR), OR
 - Interim Self Assessment or *Self Assessment
- Program Evaluation Tool Due June 30, 2016
- School Improvement Plan (SIP) Due September 1, 2016
 - Please note school reports are assigned based on school status. For Title I planning purposes, districts may choose to have School Improvement Plans submitted as early as April 1, 2016. Schools moving from Title I Targeted Assisted to Title I Schoolwide must submit by June 1, 2016.

DISTRICT REPORTS

- District Requirements Report.....Due April 22, 2016 or *4 weeks prior to AdvancED External Review
 - District Systems Review (DSR), OR
 - District Interim Self Assessment or *District Self Assessment

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- District Improvement Plan (DIP) or Due June 30, 2016
Single Building District Improvement Plan (SBDIP)
- Program Evaluation Tool Due June 30, 2016

School Reports should be reviewed by superintendents and accepted for the purposes of fulfilling the requirements of the Michigan School Accountability Score Cards. AdvancED accredited entities submit the Interim Self-Assessment or Self-Assessment reports for purposes of the School Report Card.
