SUBJECT: Model Anti-Bullying Policy

Section 380.1310b of The Revised School Code requires the board of a school district or intermediate school district, or board of directors of a public-school academy, adopt and implement a policy prohibiting bullying at school. The Matt Epling Safe School Law was signed on January 10, 2015 and went into effect on March 31, 2015. Under this law, districts are required to have anti-bullying policies that include cyberbullying as a form of bullying and identify procedures for notification to parents, as well as procedures for reporting, investigating, and documenting incidents. Over the course of the next few months, the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is committed to reviewing and revising as necessary its model anti-bullying policy adopted on November 9, 2010. Changes in state law and new research on prevention in the last decade will inform policy revisions.
