**SUBJECT**: School Bus Replacement Grants

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is offering up to \$12,961,400 in grants for the replacement of old diesel school buses with new propane, compressed natural gas, diesel, hybrid, or electric school buses. Grants are funded from an environmental settlement with Volkswagen.

Vehicle replacement costs can be partially funded by percentage. For governmentowned and privately-owned school buses under contract with a public school district, awards will be:

- Up to 25 percent of the cost of a new diesel school bus.
- Up to 40 percent of the cost of a new alternate fueled school bus.
- Up to 70 percent of the cost of a new all-electric school bus and charging station.

An informational webinar will be held on January 10, 2019, from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. Applications for electric school buses are due by February 15, 2019, and all other school bus applications are due by October 15, 2019.
