September 3, 2021- Bulletin No. 5 - Michigan Nutrition Data System transitioning to Michigan Nutrition Data System 2.0 (MiND 2.0)

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We are excited to announce that the Michigan Nutrition Data System (MIND) is transitioning to the **NEW** Michigan Nutrition Data System 2.0 (MIND 2.0). These are both systems that are used to certify, submit, and amend claims.

The new MIND 2.0 system will be going live on Wednesday, September 8, 2021.

What does this mean for you?

You must have a MILogin for Third Party account created and linked to your MEIS account. If you don't have this piece done before September 2, 2021, you will be locked out of the system. This means that there could be a delay in the ability to submit claims for your agency.

What else do you need to do?

You must request access to the MIND 2.0 system in your MILogin for Third Party account. Below are instructions.

Important information to know:

- Current MIND access levels will flow over to MIND 2.0.
- You must have a MILogin for Third Party account created and linked to your MEIS account, to access the MIND 2.0 system.
- Requesting and approving access to MIND 2.0 has changed. Everything will be done digitally, through email. **Refer to the MIND 2.0 User Manual for step-by-step instructions.**
- MIND 2.0 Level 3 access will be approved by the authorized signers who are listed in the Education Entity Master (EEM).
- MIND 2.0 Levels 1 and 2 will be approved by the MIND level 3.
