

Great Start Readiness Program  
Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) Results  
Review of Currently Approved Curricula  
March 2020

On February 26, 2020 the CRC completed its current cycle of work evaluating comprehensive curricula submitted for consideration as approvable for use in the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP). Publishers of a curriculum that has been on the approved list for a number of years were invited to submit for review to remain on the list. The publisher of Tools of the Mind chose not to complete the review process and it will be removed from the list. Creative Curriculum, Connect for Learning (C4L), and HighScope all submitted their curriculum materials and completed the Preschool Curriculum Model Evaluation Rubric. All three were reviewed and approved by the CRC.

Curriculum approaches that had prior approval, Montessori, Reggio Emilia and the Project Approach will remain approved.

Joining the list after approval in 2019 is Early Foundations, the proprietary curriculum of KinderCare. An ISD with a KinderCare center within its boundaries may establish GSRP sites with KinderCare serving as a community-based organization subrecipient. The ISD may choose to support the use of Early Foundations in GSRP KinderCare classrooms with the assigned Early Childhood Specialist receiving formal training in the curriculum.
