SUBJECT: Critical Shortage List for Retirees - UPDATE

Michigan Compiled Law (MCL) 38.1361 allows individuals who meet certain criteria to work in Michigan school districts, intermediate school districts, or public school academies after retirement while mitigating the impact to retiree benefits from the Michigan Public School Employees Retirement System. This law is scheduled to sunset on July 1, 2018.

The Michigan Department of Education maintains a list of critical shortage areas for the implementation of this law. The list was recently updated to include High Impact Leadership Facilitators needed for implementing research-validating models for school and school leadership reform under the U.S. Department of Education awarded SEED grants.
