Section 99K – Cybersecurity Competition Event Grant SUBJECT:

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is pleased to announce the availability of the Section 99k – Cybersecurity Competition Event Grant. The purpose of the grant is to provide pupils in grades 6-12 with expanded opportunities to improve computer science skills by participating in cybersecurity competitive events. The intent of the grant funding is to increase the number of pupils demonstrating proficiency in science and mathematics on the state assessment and to increase the number of pupils who are college and career ready upon high school graduation. This grant supports the MDE's Top 10 in 10 goals two, three, four, and six through several key activities.

All public school districts and public school academies in the State of Michigan are eligible to apply. Intermediate School Districts (ISDs) that enroll full-time students at the ISD are eligible to apply as well. A total of \$500,000 in funding for this grant has been made available from the 2017 State School Aid, P.A. 108 for public schools. The grant requirements and structure can be found in the Request for Proposal (RFP) at http://www.techplan.org/rdi/cybersecurity-grant/.

The grant application will be made available in the Michigan Electronic Grants System Plus (MEGS+). The application is tentatively scheduled for release on September 21, 2017.
