## FREE SCHOOL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

For Michigan's traditional public schools, public school academies, and registered nonpublic schools, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will help identify school plumbing containing lead. The DEQ can schedule your voluntary school site visit where we will help develop the following:

- Plumbing Assessment and Profile;
- Sampling Plan; and a
- Public Communication Plan.

Also, the DEQ will show districts how to collect an investigative sample and explain the components of a lead risk reduction education plan.

The funding is limited for these technical site visits, so if you are interested, please contact the DEQ to be added to the list. We look forward to helping each school reduce its drinking water's lead exposure.
