Application

Michigan's application for the U.S. Department of Education Green Ribbon Schools (ED-GRS) recognition program is now open. The aim of <u>U.S. Department of Education Green Ribbon Schools</u> (ED-GRS) is to inspire education institutions to strive for 21st century excellence by highlighting promising practices and resources that all can employ. To that end, the award recognizes those entities that:

- Reduce environmental impact and costs;
- Improve the health and wellness of schools, students, and staff; and
- Provide effective environmental and sustainability education.

Combined progress in ALL three of these areas, known as Pillars, serves as the basis for recognition. ED-GRS aligns with the Department's cross-cutting goals for education, including improving student, staff, and facility performance and increasing efficiency at federal, state, and local levels. It is part of a U.S. Department of Education (ED) effort to identify and communicate practices that result in improved student engagement, academic achievement, graduation rates, and workforce preparedness.
