WHEREAS, Barbara has done an exemplary job writing for and managing numerous United States Department of Agriculture competitive grants, including the Direct Certification Grant, Team Nutrition Grant, and the Administrative Review and Training Grant; and

WHEREAS, Barbara is the proud mother of Elizabeth who will soon graduate as a medical doctor from Wayne State University Medical School; and

WHEREAS, Barbara upon retirement from the MDE on October 15, 2010, plans to spend more time with her husband, William, licensed pilot and recently retired attorney from the State of Michigan, Department of Attorney General, traveling the United States in their small plane; now, therefore, be it
