

Home-schooled Student Checklist

- Home-schooled Students wishing to participate in the MME will test at their local public high school
- Local Public Schools will need to work with local home schooled students wishing to take the MME
 - Students are to contact the Local Public School directly
 - Assistance with accommodations
 - Complete the Request for ACT-Approved Accommodations form
 - Complete as much information as possible
 - Section A: List name of high school were they will test. Name of Home High School – write “Home-schooled” and enter code 969-999.
 - Section I: Submit complete diagnostic documentation in lieu of completing section I.
 - Section J: Signature required—alter the statement to affirm the student is home schooled and will test at your school.
 - Schedule time for students to complete pre-test sessions
 - Day 1 Answer Folder
 - Block K must be filled in for accurate reporting: 969-999
 - Day 2 Answer Document
 - Complete Block 17
 - Day 3 Answer Document
 - Complete Block 13
