**SUBJECT:** Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Public Reporting of Data

The federal regulations implementing the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) at §303.702(b)(1)(i)(A) require public reporting on the performance of each local service area on the targets established in the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report for each of the priority areas for Part C (Birth through age 2), *Early On*® Michigan. This on-going work allows us to realize Goal 1 within Michigan's Top 10 in 10 plan in which we seek to "Provide every child access to an aligned, high-quality P-20 system from early childhood to post-secondary attainment...to maximize lifetime learning and success."

The Part C indicators predominantly reflect data each *Early On* local service area submitted to the state and were included in the May 15, 2019 Part C Catamaran Release Strand Reports. - Indicator 5 Child Find, Ages Birth-1
- Indicator 6 Child Find, Ages Birth-3
- Indicator 7 Timeliness of Individualized Family Service Plan
- Indicator 8 Early Childhood Transition
