### CTE Completer


#### A CTE completer is a secondary CTE student who has:

- Completed courses\* covering all program standards in a state-approved CTE program.
- Taken the required technical skills assessment for that program.

#### CTE Enrollment Increase


4-year increase (2014-15 to 2018-19):

## CTE Completers Increase



## Secondary CTE Facts in 2018-2019

110,506 (23.4%) of total 9<sup>th</sup> –12<sup>th</sup> grade students (471,700) were enrolled in a CTE program.

47,314 students completed a secondary CTE program.

**51,654 (46.7%** of all CTE students) were in one or more special population categories.

91 students earned 2019 Breaking Traditions Awards: 4 Excellence Awards, 26 Merit Awards, and 61 Recognition Awards.

**72.4%** of CTE graduates surveyed reported that they are using the skills learned in their CTE programs for continuing education or in their current job.
