The first window of application is used for those delivering a new CTE program this year and are planning to report their program information in the Career and Technical Education Information System (CTEIS) this year. The second window is for programs planning implementation in the 2022-2023 school year.

New CTE program application is guided by the legislative language in the CARL D. PERKINS CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION ACT OF 2006, SEC. 134. [20 U.S.C. 2354] LOCAL APPLICATION FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS.
