**SUBJECT:** Getting Ready for Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process

(MICIP)

The Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP) is the pathway for districts to improve student outcomes by assessing whole child needs to develop plans and coordinate funding. MICIP will provide districts with a streamlined, integrated process and web-based platform that focuses on whole child needs for all children to succeed. Through the MICIP platform, districts will receive pre-populated data from MiSchoolData, the MiDataHub, and Michigan Department of Education, to reduce time on legal compliance issues, and to provide easily accessible tools and resources.

To take full advantage of data access in the MICIP platform, districts are encouraged to be a part of the MiDataHub. Signing up is easy and the benefits are great.
