**SUBJECT:** 2018-19 Report of Michigan Merit Curriculum Requirements Fulfilled by

Completion of a Career and Technical Education Program or Curriculum

The submission of the 2017-18 school year data of the Michigan Merit Curriculum requires schools to report completion of a career and technical education program or curriculum, pursuant to <a href="Section 1278a(2)(c">Section 1278a(2)(c)</a>, (MCL 380.1278a) of the Revised School Code:

- (c) Not later than September 1, 2018, and not later than September 1 of each subsequent school year, a school district or public school academy shall report to the department both of the following, in a form and manner prescribed by the department:
  - (i) The number of pupils who partially or fully fulfilled 1 credit in a language other than English by completing a department-approved formal career and technical education program or curriculum.
  - (ii) The number of pupils who partially or fully fulfilled 1 credit in a language other than English by completing visual or performing arts instruction that is in addition to the requirements of the Michigan Merit Curriculum.

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) recognizes that school districts are busy during this time of the school year; therefore, the timeline is being extended to submit the survey until October 1, 2019. All districts are required to respond to the survey, including those with no applicable students.
