SUBJECT: Public Comment Request for Math/Science Partnership (MSP) Waiver to

Extend the Period of Availability for Grant Funds

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is requesting a 12-month Tydings waiver from the U.S. Department of Education for the NCLB Title IIB Mathematics and Science Partnership Grant (84.366B) award number S366B160023. MDE anticipates needing to carry approximately \$300,000 of this grant award past September 30, 2018. This extension of federal money will allow MDE to continue to support teacher professional development in mathematics. Specifically, a new request for proposals (RFP) will solicit projects that support Math Recovery or culturally-responsive mathematics instruction.

As part of the waiver process, the MDE must provide the opportunity for the public to comment on the pending request. This communication serves to solicit the required comments. Those wishing to provide comments on this request should submit them via email to Ruth Anne Hodges, hodgesr3@michigan.gov no later than September 27, 2018.

This initiative aligns with the Michigan Department of Education Top 10 in 10 Years Goal #2, which states, "Implement, with strong district and building leadership, high-quality instruction in every classroom through a highly coherent, child-centered instructional model where students meet their self-determined academic and personal goals to their highest potential.
