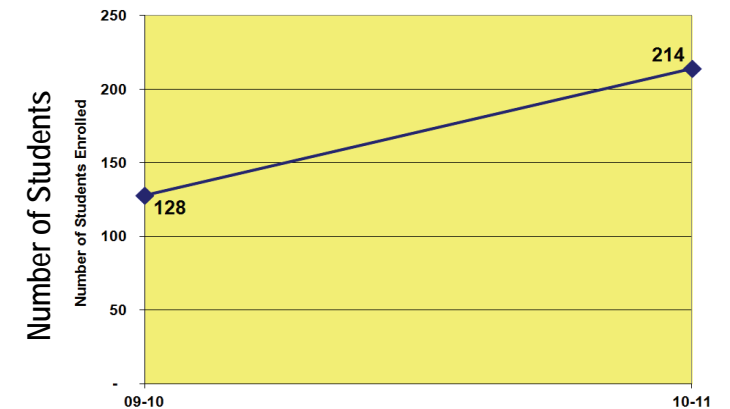

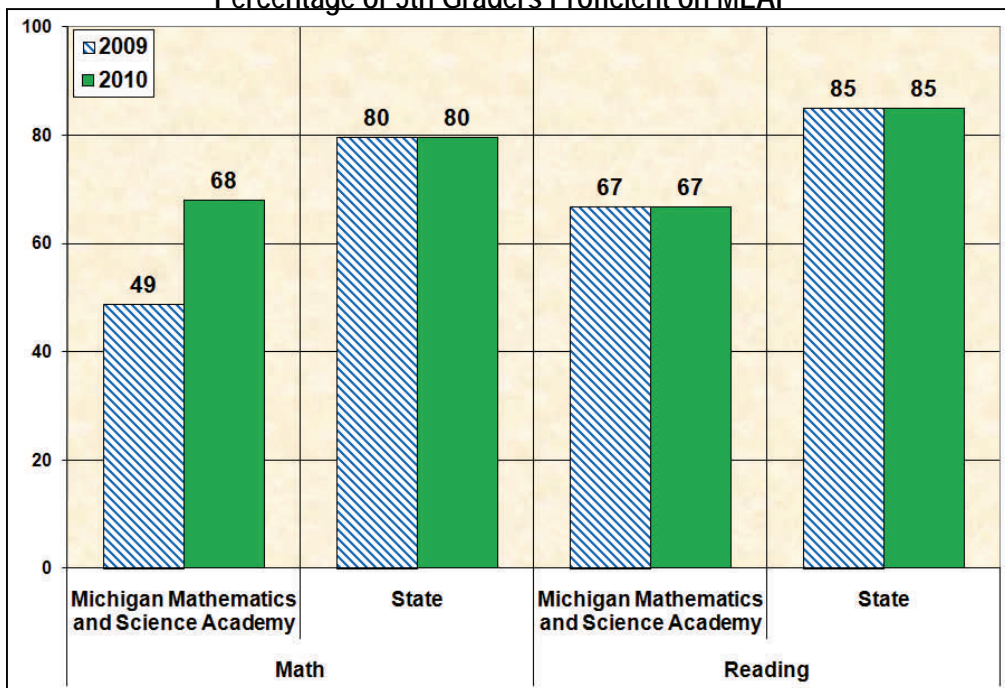

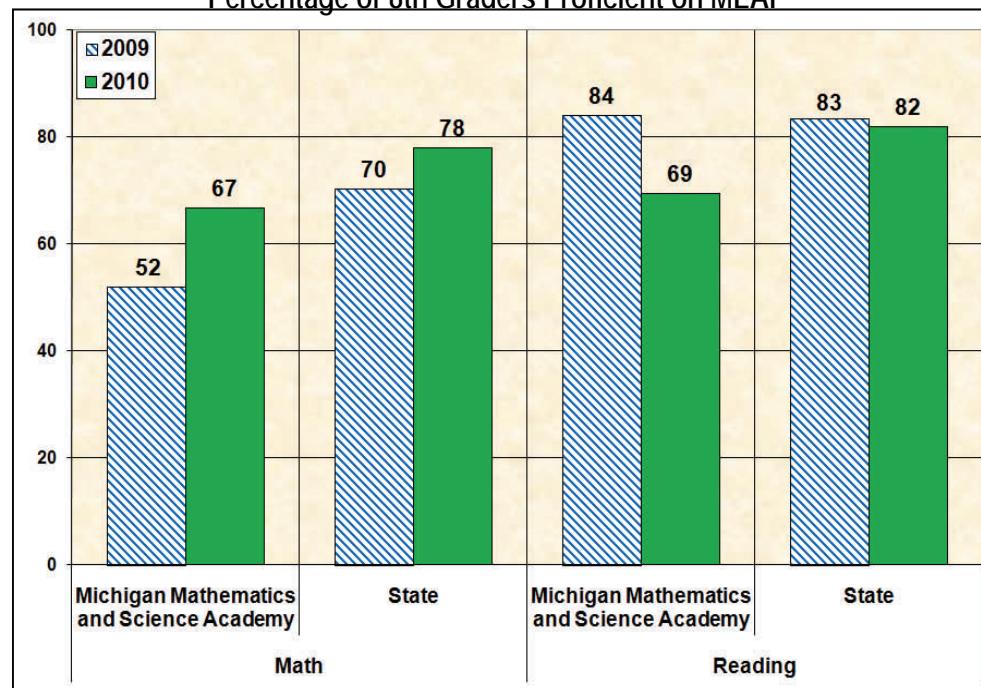
Student Progress from 2009 to 2010 on MEAP tests for 7th to 8th Grade

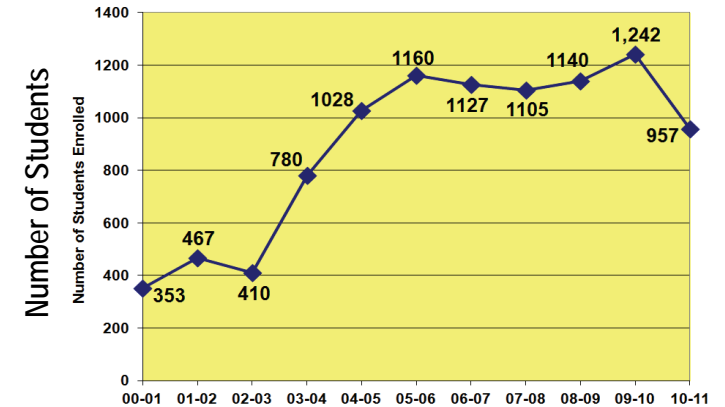

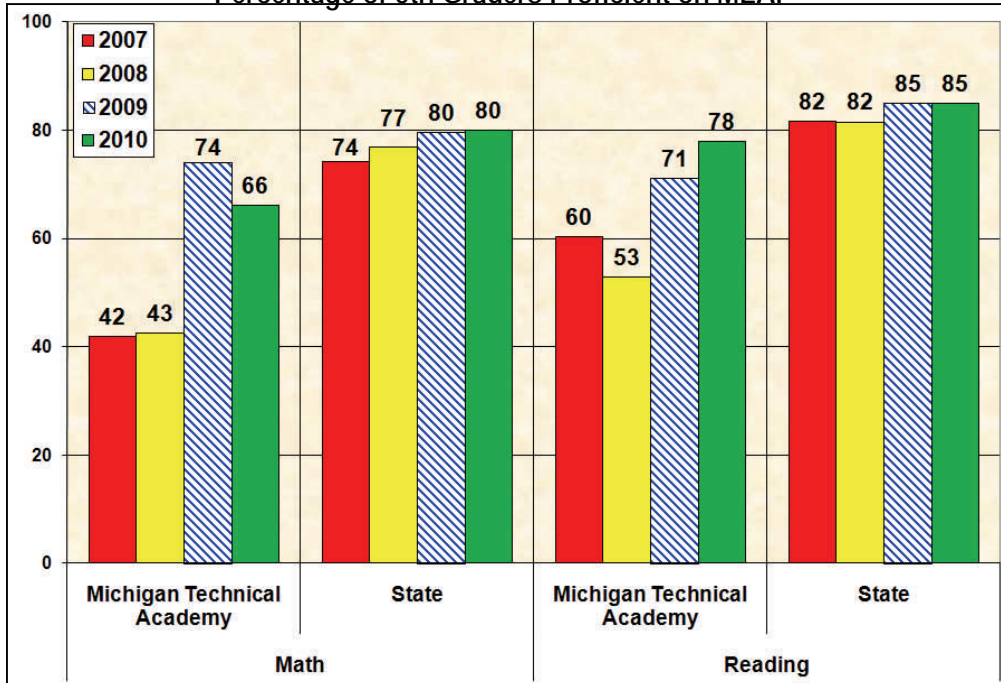

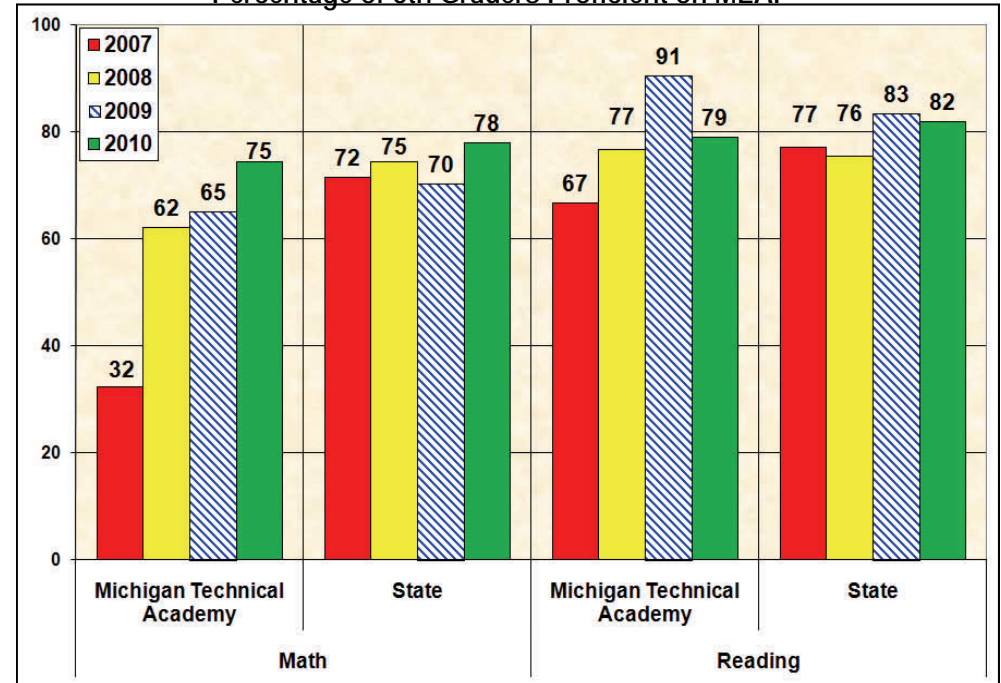
Student Progress from 2009 to 2010 on MEAP tests for 7th to 8th Grade

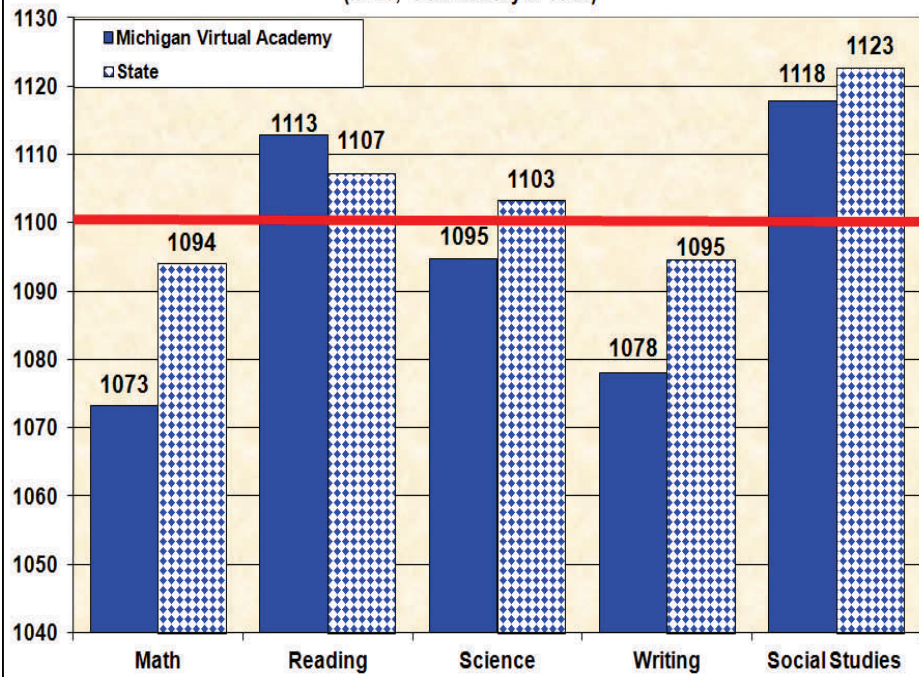

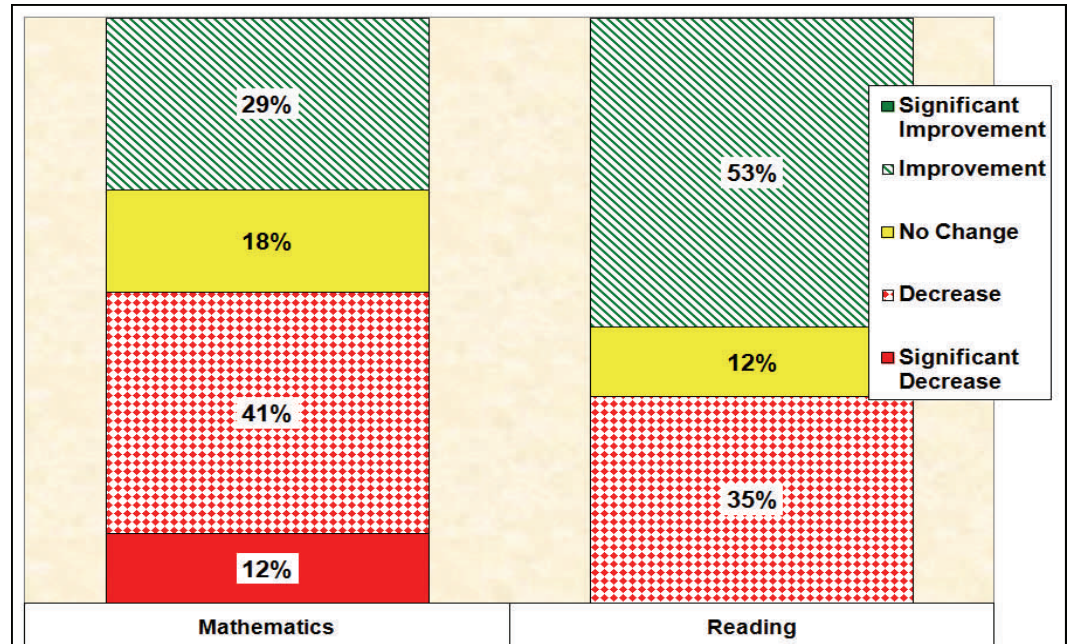

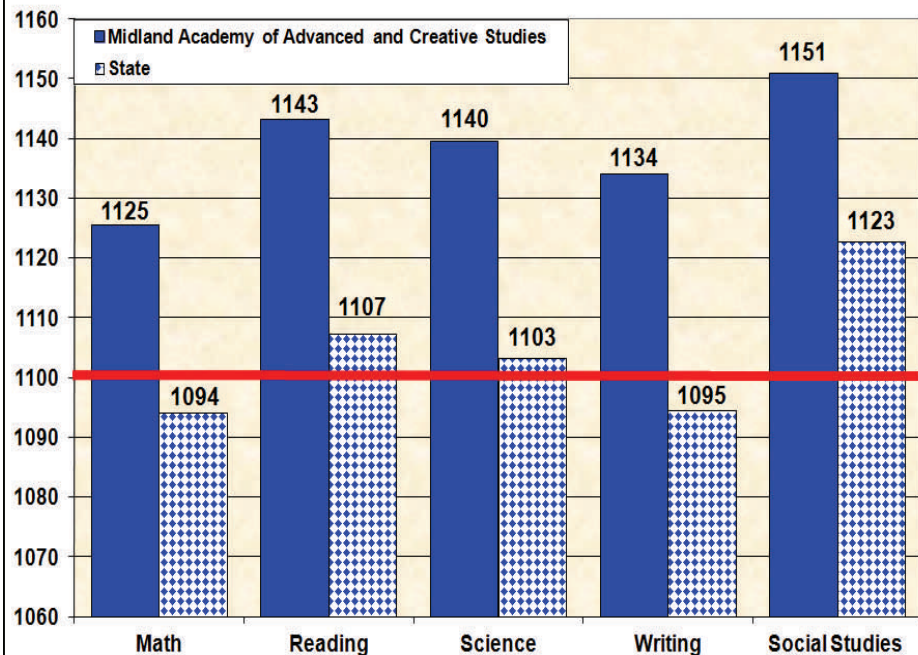

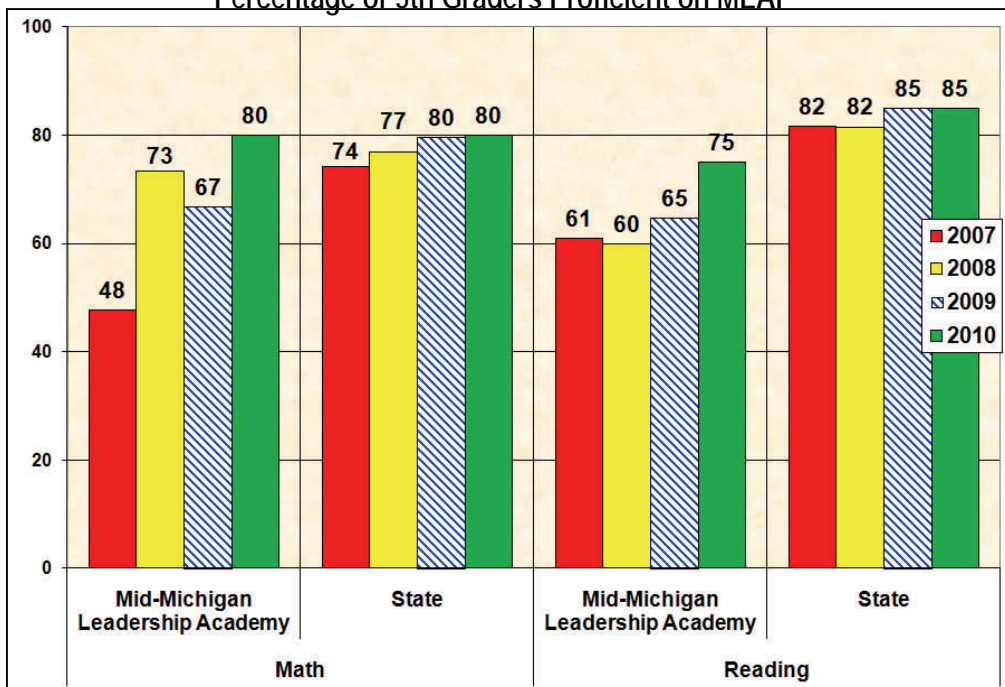

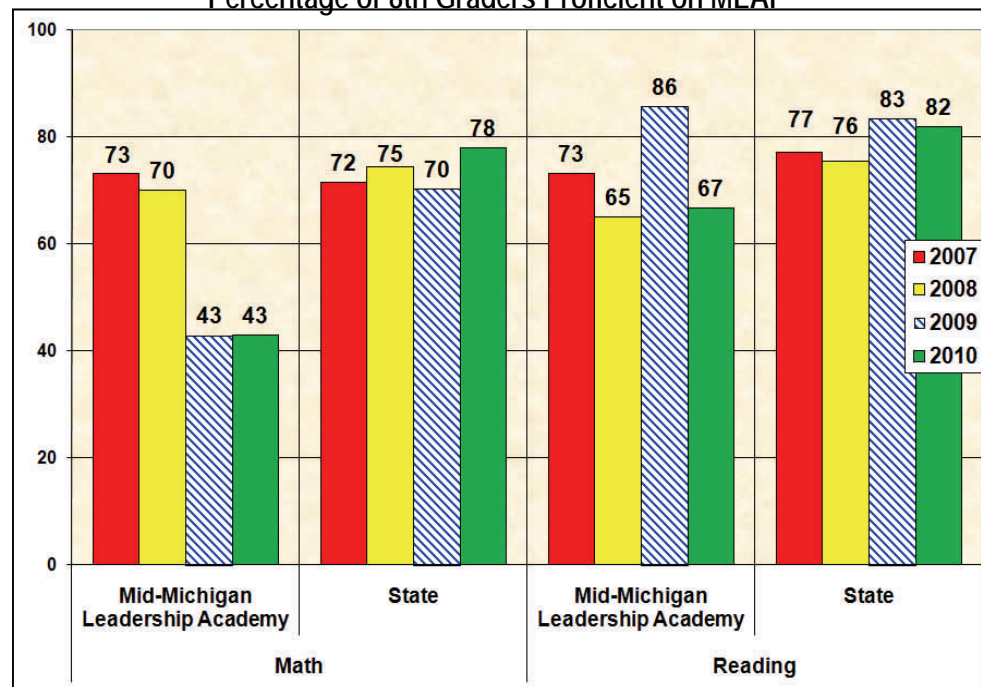
Student Progress from 2009 to 2010 on MEAP tests for 7th to 8th Grade

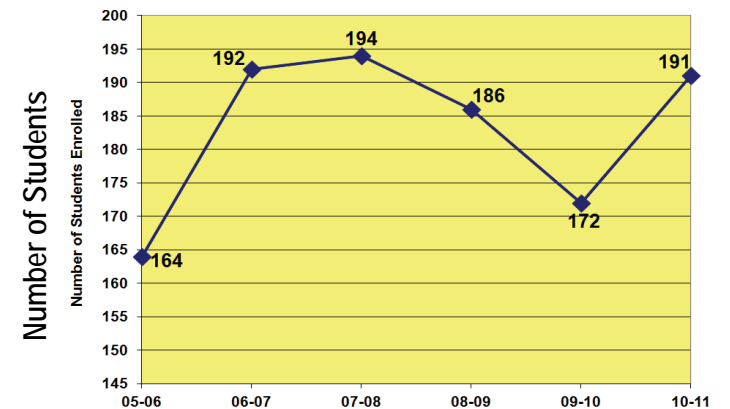

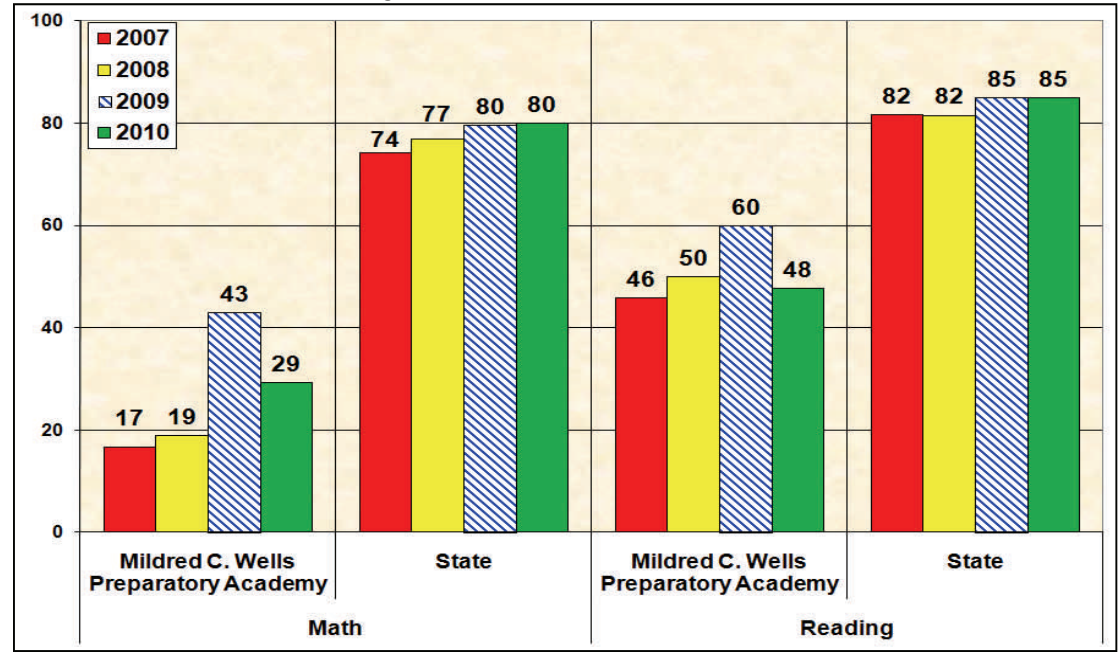

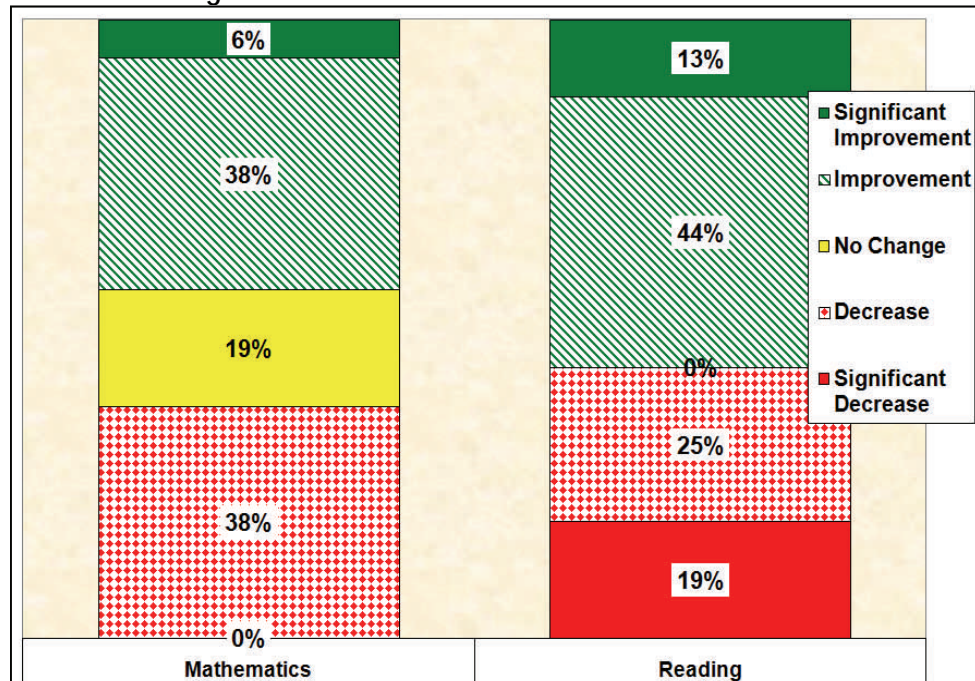

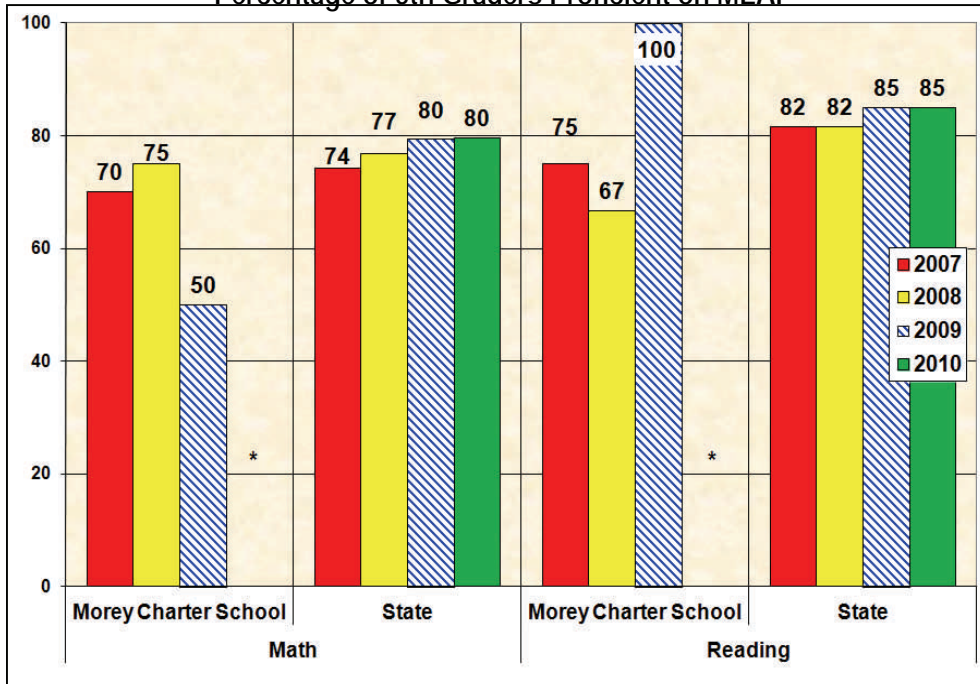

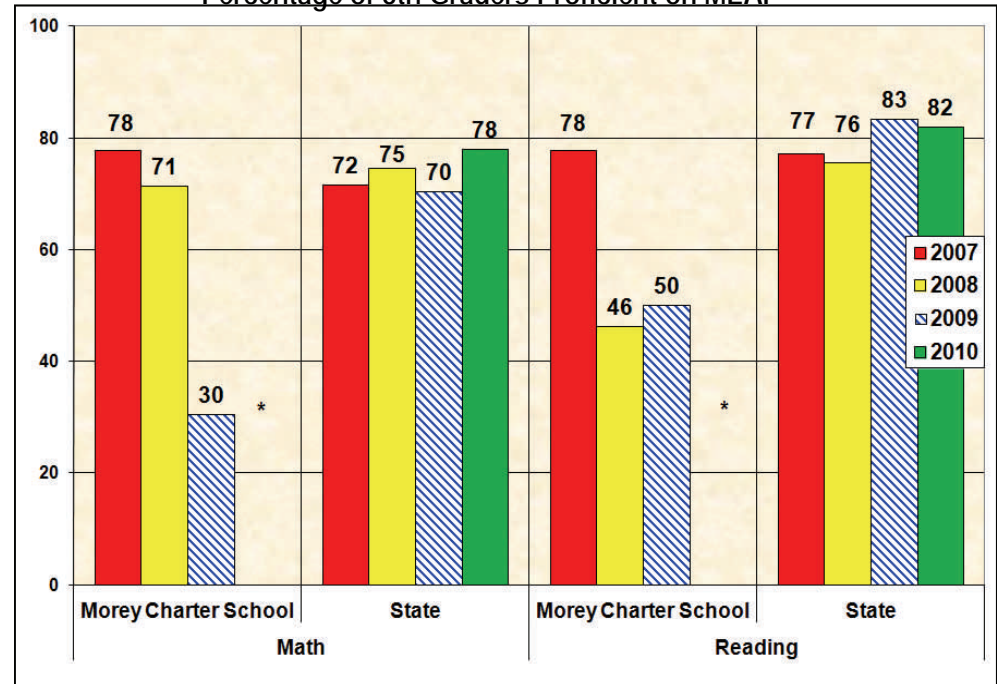
Student Progress from 2009 to 2010 on MEAP tests for 7th to 8th Grade

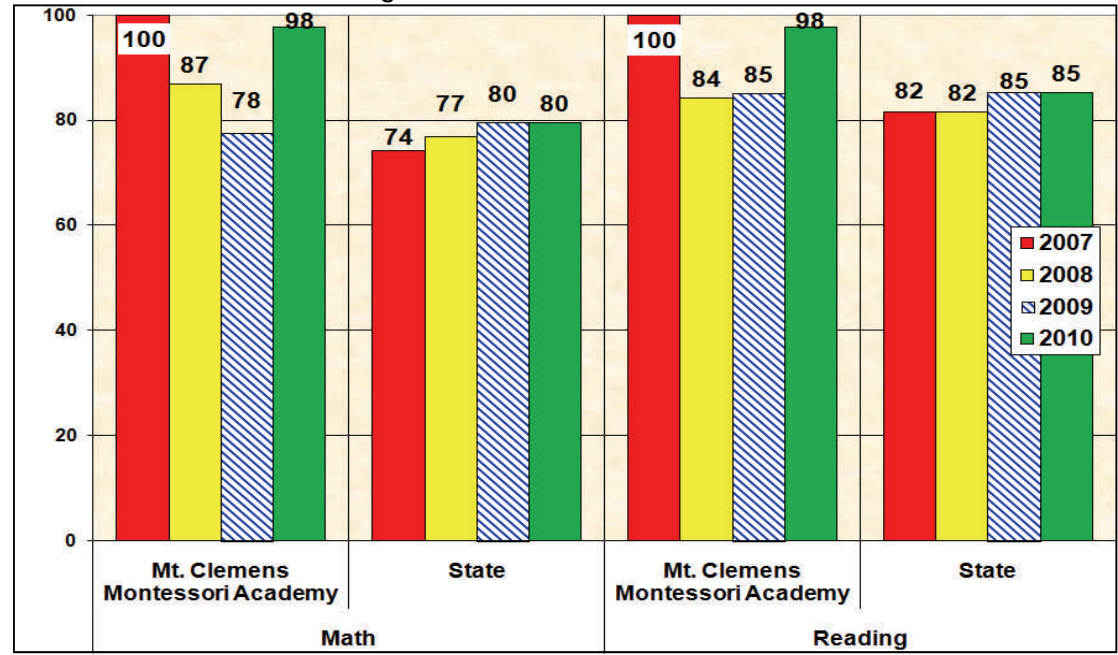

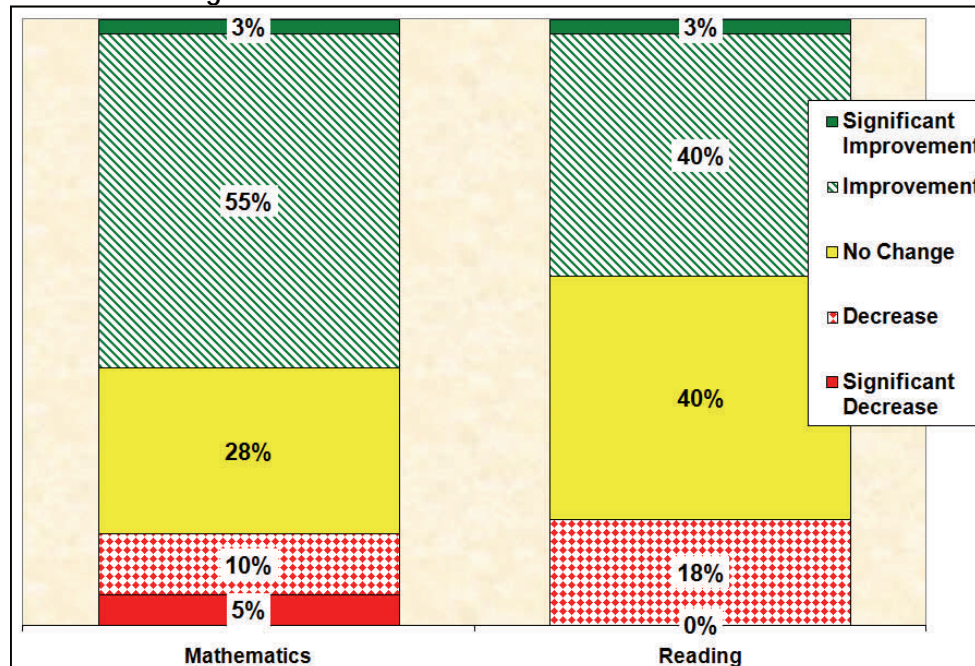

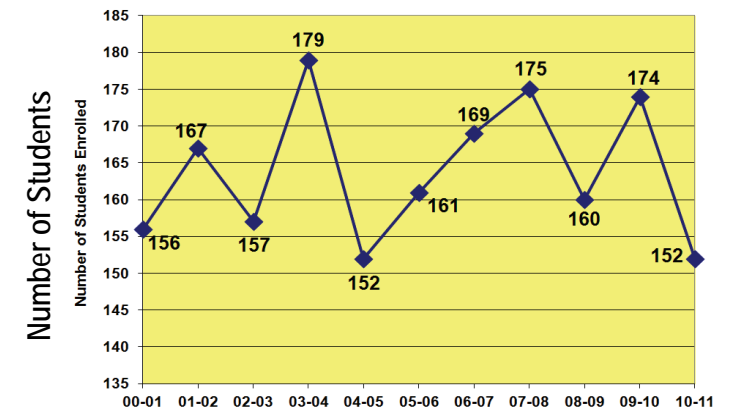

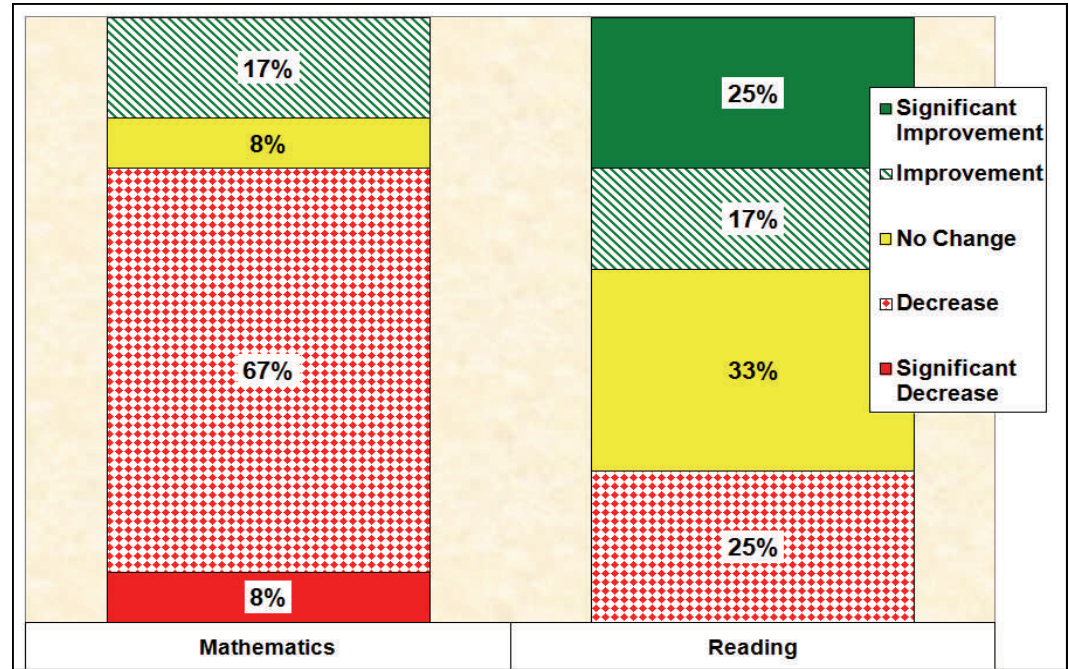

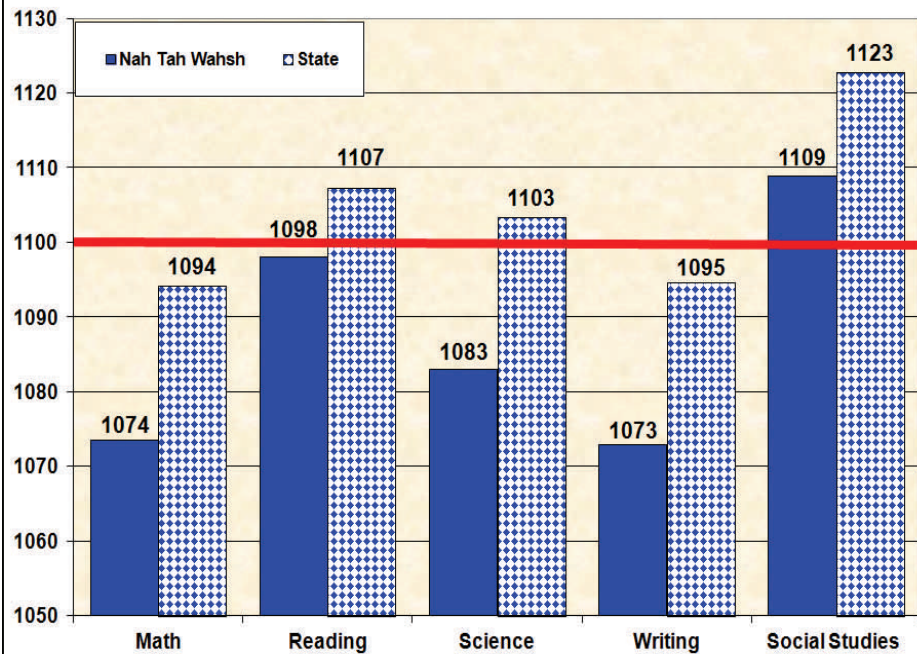

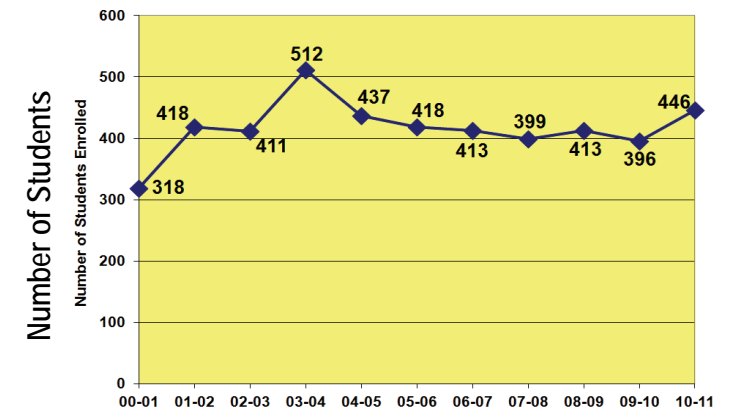

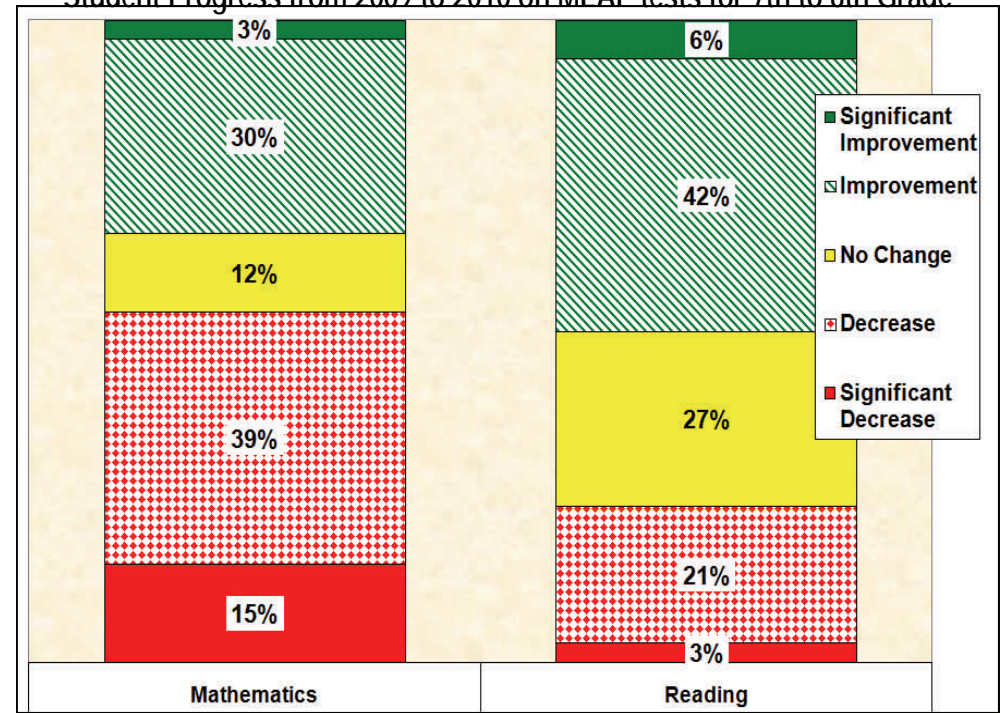

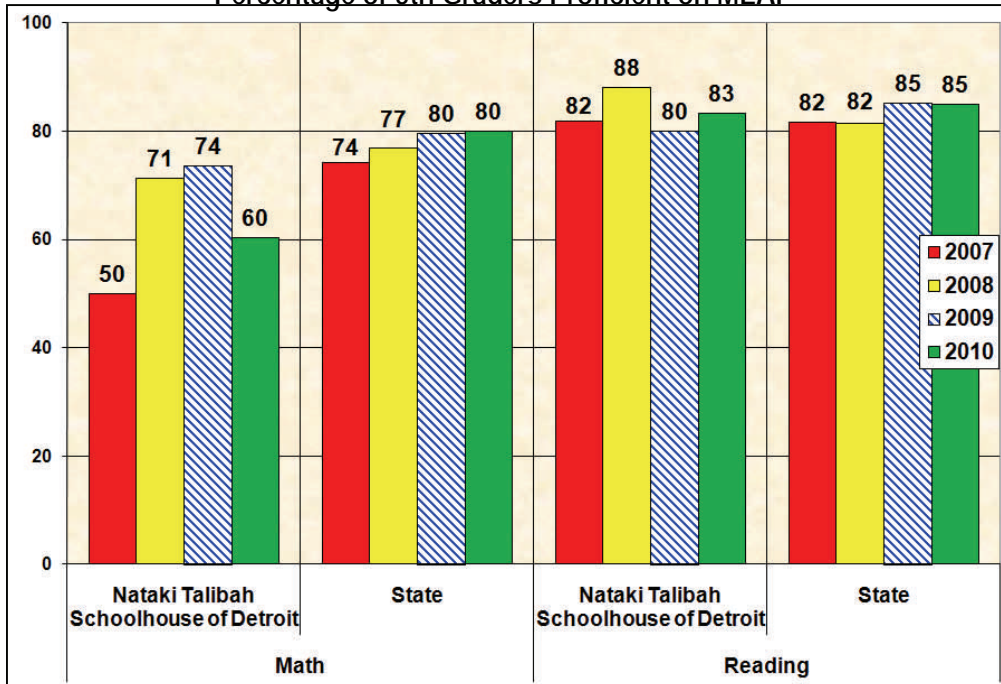
